



RECLAIM THE PAST

The sustainable wooden house, constructed from Douglas fir, is on the footprint and foundations of a cattle shed, part of an old farm that was recently developed. It has optimal insulation, triple glazing, a ground-source heat pump and solar panels. Inside, the couple used natural materials, wood, wool, linen, recycled fabrics and ceramics, plus lots of vintage furnishings. In the main living area, Larissa designed a shade (made by Ineke Visser) from an existing frame and hand-dyed wools, which dictated the palette of warm shades used throughout their home
